Golden Eagle Choir, students start to apply more complex musical concepts such as tuning, blend, and balance, and practice advanced level (2 & 3 part)music in a group ensemble. The class meets everyday. Golden Eagle Choir is considered a regularly scheduled core subject and all attendance and grading procedures apply.

Objectives of Performing Arts:

Students will be expected to demonstrate:

- a knowledge of music theory, including solfege, intervals, song mapping and how it is applied to vocal arts.
- the acquisition of technical skill to produce outstanding tone and ability in their chosen vocal range.
- a working knowledge of music vocabulary and symbol identification.
- knowledge of complex rhythms and how to count them with a steady beat.
- an ability to perform before an audience, and to demonstrate an understanding of, and skills in music performance techniques, including appropriate concert attire.

Tools for Success:

- Pencil
- Folder for Music (generously provided by the Band Boosters)
- Water for class
- Membership in the Google Classroom
- Knowledge of the <u>www.semschoir.com</u> website
- Concert Attire: Black Dress Shirt, Black Dress pants or skirt, Black socks or tights, Black dress shoes. Ladies may wear long black dresses with sleeves if they prefer. Ties may also be worn for flair.

Grading:

Golden Eagle Choir Grades are based on the following breakdown:

- Concerts/Performances: 30%
- Singing Tests: 20%
- Class Rehearsal and Bringing Materials to Class: 50%

All choir students are expected to attend all performances as part of their semester grades. If an emergency/conflict arises, students/parents must email their director ASAP.

Participation and effort are the most important aspects of choir class.

Behavior Expectations/Classroom Rules:

The Choir Room at SEMS is a special place where you are safe to grow and learn. The great behavior of our students is part of what makes this happen. We all make mistakes at one time or another, but the important thing is to correct and learn from these mistakes. As a music student, you are expected to follow the class rules at all times.

Singing Tests

There will be singing tests during each semester. Students are expected to practice the assigned passages and be prepared for these assessments. Section leaders and directors are available for additional help. Students may submit the assessments via the Google Classroom, Band app, or email. Certain tests may also be conducted live.

<u>Leadership</u>

In Golden Eagle Choir, there are leadership opportunities for students. These include section leaders and Concertmaster. Section leaders are assigned on the basis of singing ability on music. At the director's discretion, there may be challenge opportunities for the section leader position. Concertmaster is a position that is elected by the choir class. There are no challenges for Concertmaster.
